## **Breakout Group Worksheet**

#### **Outcomes for Breakout Discussions:**

- Engage the academic community in a deeper understanding of <u>OPC Strategic Plan</u> goals, objectives and targets.
- Identify areas where the academic community can best advance the science and other needs identified in the OPC Strategic Plan.
- Facilitate networking between OPC, OST, CASG, agencies and academic scientists
- Identify challenges and opportunities for funding the work

#### Instructions:

Each table will discuss one of the OPC Strategic Plan Goals and the associated objectives. Select a member of the group to take notes on the large pads and someone to report out in plenary discussion. Pick at least three prompts (see below) and discuss for 20 minutes.

Include the letters of the prompts in your summary notes. You will change tables once in each session to discuss a second OPC Strategic Plan Goal. After the groups have met we will ask for reports from each table to summarize the discussion.

### **Breakout Prompts:**

In order to achieve the OPC Strategic Plan goals and objectives:

- A. What are the core science gaps that academic researchers (including graduate students) can fill, what are the challenges?
- B. What are key educational and training needs that universities can support?
- C. What are the opportunities for funding this work, how can we leverage and coordinate existing funding programs more effectively?
- D. How can academic and state agencies partner more effectively? And what are the challenges?
- E. How can we enhance communication and coordination within and between academic organizations as well as externally among funders, stakeholders, and research institutions?
